The Mauritius Ports Authority (MPA) is inviting bids from local and overseas bidders for the Design, Supply, Installation and Commissioning of Centralised Access Control and CCTV Systems for Port Area Surveillance as more fully described in the bidding document.

Bidding exercise will be conducted through Open International Bidding method according to the rules and regulations of the Republic of Mauritius.

Description of Project

The MPA intends to implement a modern CCTV system fully integrated with a port wide Access Control System with a view to strengthen security measures in the port area.

The Scope of the project includes inter alia the following:

- Design, Supply, Install and Commission a new CCTV System;
- Design, Supply, Install and Commission a port wide centralised Access Control System;
- Design, Supply, Install and Commission a Networking System using both fibre and wireless to support the above Systems;
- Provision of maintenance on the above; and
- Provision of a Disaster Recovery Site.

Qualification requirements

Bidders should have the following minimum qualification criteria to be considered as eligible for the project:

- At least **five (5) years** of experience in the supply and installation of similar CCTV and Access Control systems.
- Experience as **prime contractor in the implementation of at least one project of similar scale/nature including an integrated CCTV and centralized access control system over the last 5 years**; and
- Other qualifying criteria mentioned in the bid document.
