The Ministry of Land Transport and Light Rail invites bids from eligible bidders of both Mauritian Nationals or entities incorporated in Mauritius and foreigners /open to local and International bidders through the e-procurement system for the Construction and Installation of Traffic and Road Safety Devices (2021-2023) within a framework agreement.
